Small amount of twigs on fire to make BBQ beside canal foot path. fire was stamped out. Advice given to those having BBQ.

Used BBQ spread to adjacent cardboard and wooden garden shed. Severe fire damage to shed, its contents and adjacent wooden gate. Heat damage to toilet overflow pipe on side of house. Light smoke damage inside of house.

Adults having a BBQ in band stand.

Small fire involving fencing due to careless disposal of BBQ charcoal.

Smoke from BBQ near properties out building.

2 x portable BBQs left unattended.

False alarm good intent - BBQ smoker in rear garden.

False alarm good intent - Caused by melting snow on BBQ ignition switch.

Out on arrival. BBQ in waste bin. BBQ was removed from bin by Fire Service.

2 x fence panels and 1 x BBQ damaged by fire.

Accidental BBQ coals in skip.

Quantity of rubbish in large commercial bin involved in fire. Caused by careless disposal of disposable BBQ.

Small fire in grease trap on BBQ. Out on arrival. No action. Advice given.

BBQ in communal area.

BBQ spread to dry hedge and fence. Neighbours fence and gate destroyed. Neighbours garage fascia, guttering and roof suffered fire damage to one corner of the building.

Fire started by hot coals from BBQ being left next to wooden fence situated close to car. This spread to car and recycling bins which in turn damaged external face of kitchen door by fire and radiated heat to first floor bathroom window.
