Please note that our recording system holds data going only as far back as 01/10/2018.

Incidents attended by Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service between 01/10/2018 and 30/06/2025, where the property type was recorded as "Caravan on tow", "Caravan unspecified" or "Towing caravan elsewhere (not on tow)".

Animal fatalities are not routinely recorded.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you are unhappy with how your request has been handled or you do not think the decision is correct, you have the right to require the Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service to review their decision.

Prior to lodging a formal appeal you are welcome and encouraged to discuss the decision with the case officer that dealt with your request.

Ask to have the decision looked at again

The quickest and easiest way to have the decision looked at again is to telephone the case officer that is nominated at the end of your decision letter. That person will be able to discuss the decision, explain any issues and assist with any problems.

Appeal

If you are dissatisfied with the handling procedures or the decision that Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) regarding access to information, you can lodge an appeal with the Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service to have the decision reviewed.

Where possible the Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service will aim to respond to your appeal within 20 working days. However meeting this time scale will depend upon the circumstances and complexity of the issue.

The Information Commissioner

After lodging an appeal with the Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service, if you are still dissatisfied with the decision, you may make an application to the Information Commissioner for a decision on whether the request for information has been dealt with in accordance with the requirements of the Act.
